001⁽²⁴⁾ Apologies and Reasons for Absence.

Apologies were received from Cllrs N Roynon (holiday) and B Carter (holiday).

002⁽²⁴⁾ Declarations of Interests from members regarding the agenda.

No declarations of interest were received.

003⁽²⁴⁾ Public Forum Session

Several residents raised questions concerning the recent marketing and planning applications for the Bell House Hotel. The applicant and developer stated their interest in the Parish Council's response to the applications.

004⁽²⁴⁾ Minutes for Approval
